Grasslands comprise less than 1% of BC's land base, and are home to more than onethird of BC's endangered and at-risk species, according to BC Grasslands.

Of all of BC's grasslands, those in the East Kootenays are under the most serious pressure, from human development.

Clear Sky's first Team Charter was created because of the Grasslands project.











Before: June 13, 2010 - right after our course, when we added manure, seeded and planted plugs.




July 13, 2010 - one month later, after watering.


